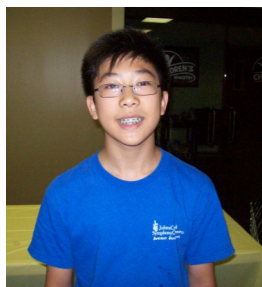
Please send in bag lunch each day. Snacks and drinks will be provided.
